Sixth Form Catering:

As a member of the Sixth Form, your son/daughter may choose to eat off-site at lunch-time. Please see below for information relating to food offered on-site at the College.

At St Richard Reynolds we are committed to the provision of a healthy food provision. Our meals are freshly prepared on site by our preferred caterers, Wilson Jones. There is a varied choice catering for all tastes incorporating all the vital aspects needed for a healthy diet.

A flexible choice of on-site catering options is available for Sixth Form students. Students have the choice of a full cooked meal, or sandwiches/snacks. Your son/daughter must make cash payment for any items purchased.

Students may bring in a packed lunch as an alternative to school meals.

Payments: School Shop

Once registered you will be able to pay for all College activities/contributions, and top up your son/daughter's school printing balance via the School Shop.
